

## REPORT ON COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITY IN MAMBRUI, MALINDI ON 30<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2015.

Following the educational excursion made by the Architecture Fourth Year Class, from the 28<sup>th</sup> November to 5<sup>th</sup> December 2015. After conducting an introduction to the community leaders, and a subsequent visit to a historic monument and ancestral graveyard of Mambui. Being a relatively small town, it was proposed that a session to both introduce and interact with locals be arranged, with a henna decoration session being chosen as the ideal way to accomplish this.
